Roman leaders had divided the empire in 395, largely due to difficulties in communications between the eastern and the troubled western parts of the empire Still, rulers in the East continued to see themselves as emperors for all of Rome In 527, a high-ranking Byzantine nobleman named Justinian succeeded his uncle to the throne of the Eastern
