Guide to Informational Interviewing - Psychology

Although you do not need 100 questions prepared for the informational interview, it's a good idea to prepare your top 10 What are your goals? What do you want to learn about the work they do? Maybe you are not as interested in the company as you are in the position they hold Identify your questions after you have done your company research and

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- The clinical interview usually takes place during a formally arranged meeting
- The clinical interview has a specific purpose
- The interviewer chooses the topics or broad content of the discussion
- The interviewer and interviewee have a defined relationship—the interviewer asks questions, the interviewee responds to the questions
